Saida and George Rashmawi, who are volunteer members from the Roman Catholic Church in the Holy Land at Bethlehem, will be visiting our parish on the weekend of June 17. They will speak to us about the Christian struggles in the Holy Land. They will also have some beautiful Olive Wood carvings which are all handmade by the Catholic people in Bethlehem, for sale after the Masses, June 17.

The purpose of this visit is to help maintain the existence of the Catholic people in the Holy Land.
