Holy Week

It is in the liturgy of Holy Week that the entire Church officially remembers and celebrates the mysteries of our redemption. On **Palm Sunday**, palms are blessed and distributed. Carrying these palms we praise him, as did the people of Jerusalem at Christ's triumphal entry into the Holy City as he came to begin his Passion. On **Holy Thursday** we celebrate the anniversary of the Last Supper by a Mass which expresses both our joy and gratitude for the great gifts the Eucharist, our common call to service, and our deep mourning at the Passion of Christ that began on that night. The service on **Good Friday** is not a Mass; it is a service that concentrates, rather, on the bloody death of Christ on the first Good Friday. The service consists of readings, prayers and the Passion according to St. John, veneration of the cross and Holy Communion. After the service the church is left empty and silent; the altar is bare. From then until Easter we relive the time when the dead body of Christ lay in the tomb. The resurrection of Christ and its profound meaning in our lives is brought home to us in the liturgy of **Easter**.
