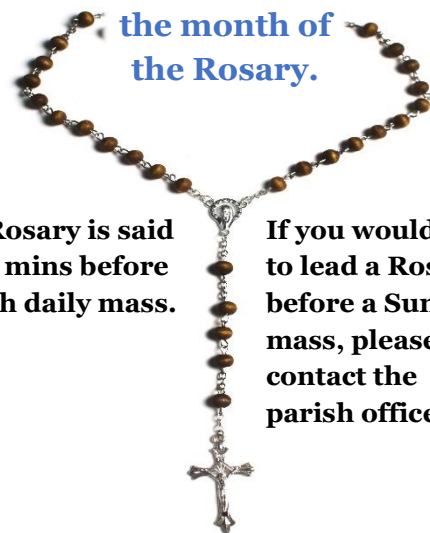

would like to thank all the St. Thomas the Apostle and St. Bridget parishioners for their generosity last Sunday during the second collection. We raised \$895.

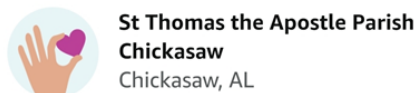
