

Brief History of St. Bridget Catholic Church

Long before the turn of the 18th Century, when the town of Whistler was still young, the Jesuit priests came from Spring Hill College to say mass in the homes of the parishioners in the area.

On August 25, 1864, Jacob & Mary Magee deeded a parcel of land on Engine Street (now Main Street) to Bishop John Quinlan, to be used as a place of worship by the Catholics of the area. The church of St. Bridget of Ireland was dedicated three years later.

The original church and rectory at were built by Rev. Edward Kirwin, St. Bridget's first pastor, and was dedicated in 1867 but was destroyed by a storm. It was then rebuilt in 1874.

The last big renovation to St. Bridget's buildings occurred about 20 years ago.

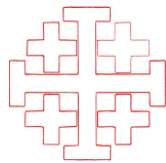

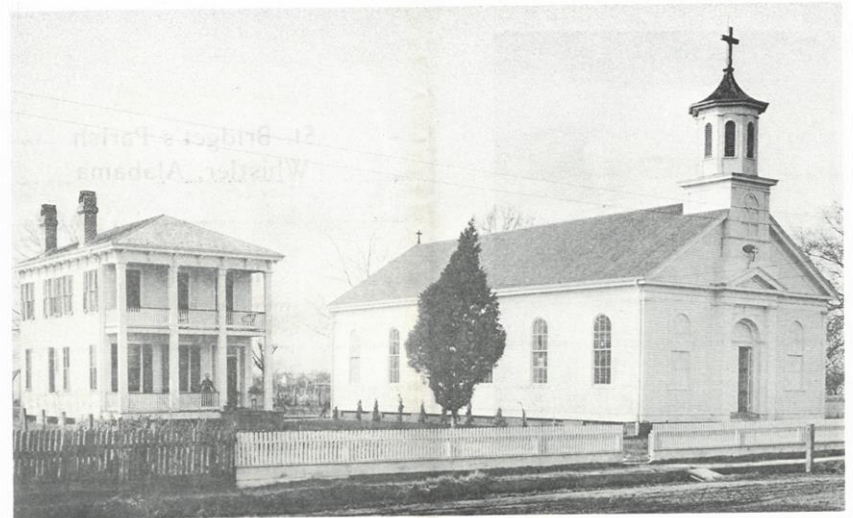

September is Dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrows

10 WAYS YOU CAN HONOR OUR LADY OF SORROWS:

1 DON'T RUN FROM THE SORROWS OF OTHERS.

Be fully present to them, even when their difficulty is hard for you to think about. Really listen when someone wants to talk about a worry, a grief, a pain, or a loneliness and offer time and empathy.

2 PUT EMPATHY INTO ACTION.

Offer to help ease the suffering of another, carrying their cross for a bit, like Simon of Cyrene. Offer to drive a friend to the doctor, visit someone in the hospital, pray a Rosary for a friend's special intention, babysit for an overwhelmed mom or spend time with an elderly relative while their caretaker has some time to themselves.

3 BRING AN IMAGE OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS TO SOMEONE WHO IS SUFFERING.

It could be a painting, a prayer card, a statue, or even a computer printout. In this way you can offer them the companionship of her compassion and the opportunity to offer their sorrows up, giving their pain a greater purpose.

4 PRAY THE POWERFUL SEVEN SORROWS ROSARY OR THE SEVEN SORROWS DEVOTION.

The Seven Sorrows devotion involves praying seven Hail Marys a day, each one while meditating on one of Our Lady's seven sorrows, which are:

- The prophecy of Simeon.
- The flight into Egypt.
- The loss of the Child Jesus in the temple.
- The meeting of Jesus and Mary on the Way of the Cross.
- The Crucifixion and Death of Jesus.
- The taking down of the Body of Jesus from the Cross and preparation for burial.
- The burial of Jesus.

5 DONATE SOMETHING.

6 PRAY DAILY FOR SOMEONE WHO'S SUFFERING AND LET THEM KNOW.

O God, in Whose Passion a sword of sorrow pierced the most dear soul of the glorious Virgin-Mother, Mary, as foretold by Simeon, mercifully grant that we who reverently commemorate Her sorrows, may obtain the blessed effect of Thy Passion. Who livest and reignest, in the unity of the Holy Ghost, God, world without end.
Amen.

7 LIGHT A CANDLE AT YOUR PARISH CHURCH BEFORE A STATUE OF OUR LADY.

8 MAKE AN ALTAR TO OUR LADY OF SORROWS IN YOUR HOME.

Choose an image of the Sorrowful Virgin and adorn it with flowers that you'll keep refreshing all month as a little act of tenderness, and candles that you light during prayer.

9 FIND AN IMAGE OF THE "PIETA" BY MICHELANGELO.

Meditate upon its searing beauty as it inspires you in prayer. With this sublime sculpture, Michelangelo shaped the sixth sorrow of Mary into one of the all-time greatest works of art.

10 LISTEN TO STABAT MATER FOR ALTO SOLO RV 621.

Composed by a Catholic priest, Fr. Antonio Vivaldi, it translates as "Sorrowful Mother." It's incomparable beauty is perfect to accompany or inspire prayer.
