Baptism of infants: If you are expecting a child or have recently had a child and want to prepare for baptism, please call the parish office to schedule a preparation session.

First Eucharist, Confirmation, RCIA : Contact our parish office for more information.

Matrimony: Contact our parish office 6 months prior to intended date of the wedding. We follow all Archdiocesan policies and guidelines.

Annulments: Fr. Saucier and Deacon Groves are available to discuss questions concerning annulments. There is no cost associated with annulments.




Renting Guidelines: Please contact the parish office one month before the event for fees, paperwork and Archdiocesan Guidelines.

Fast & Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence.

In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

> The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until 59.

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

The norms concerning abstinence from meat are from age 14 onwards.
