Baptism of infants: If you are expecting a child or have recently had a child and want to prepare for baptism, please call the parish office to schedule a preparation session.

First Eucharist, Confirmation, RCIA : Contact our parish office for more information.

Matrimony: Contact our parish office 6 months prior to intended date of the wedding. We follow all Archdiocesan policies and guidelines.

Anointing of the Sick, Homebound: Please keep Fr. Saucier or the Parish Office informed of anyone who is homebound, hospitalized, seriously ill or wishes to receive Holy Communion or Anointing of the Sick. Contact the parish office at 251-452-9837 or Rectory 251-456-7931

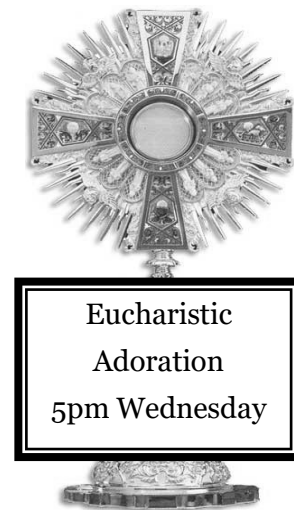

Archdiocesan Eucharistic Procession

At 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 15, Archbishop Rodi will celebrate Mass in the Cathedral-Basilica of the Immaculate Conception.

At this Mass he will consecrate the host which will be used for our portion of the Eucharistic Procession. The procession will begin as we recess from Mass. It will end at St. Mary Parish Church with a talk about the connection between being people of the Eucharist and being people of service.

After this talk, most pilgrims will be dismissed. There will be a shuttle available to return pilgrims to their cars that were left at the Cathedral.
