Baptism of infants: If you are expecting a child or have recently had a child and want to prepare for baptism, please call the parish office to schedule a preparation session.

First Eucharist, Confirmation, RCIA : Contact our parish office for more information.

Matrimony: Contact our parish office 6 months prior to intended date of the wedding. We follow all Archdiocesan policies and guidelines.

Anointing of the Sick, Homebound: Please keep Fr. Saucier or the Parish Office informed of anyone who is homebound, hospitalized, seriously ill or wishes to receive Holy Communion or Anointing of the Sick. Contact the parish office at 251-725-1556

Annulments: Fr. Saucier and Deacon Groves are available to discuss questions concerning annulments. There is no cost associated with annulments.
