Matrimony: Contact our parish office six months prior to intended date of the wedding. We follow all Archdiocesan policies and guidelines.

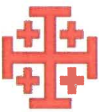
Annulments: Fr. Saucier and Deacon Groves are available to discuss questions concerning annulments. There is no cost associated with annulments.
